### 1. Welcome From UIL

- Thank you for your flexibility and your commitment.
- 77<sup>th</sup> year of Texas UIL music
- UIL music serves over 750,000 students in Texas. This is divided into 33 music regions. We are the 7<sup>th</sup> largest region in the state.
- Region 27 serves 10 school districts. We had 4600 individual S & E entries and 423 ensembles competing in Marching & Concert & Sightreading in 22-23. This is up about 100 S & E events and 20 Group events. This puts us back to the number of ensembles we had in 2020 prior to COVID shutting us down.
- I see more names on the TMAA list from this Region-thanks for doing that. I understand several new members were approved at the summer convention. Don't forget to go online in November/December and apply for TMAA membership if you meet the qualifications. <u>https://www.txmaa.org/Applications/</u>

- Region Address: This will change in September. Once it has changed, I will let you know, and I will change it in the UIL FORMS system. I will also take care of sending new W-9 forms to your school districts. If you use your booster account to pay fees and need a W-9, I will ask you to respond to the email I send. Please do not mail anything for now.
- Communication is key
  - ✓ Know if the event is a UIL or TMEA Event
  - ✓ UIL is Marching Contest, HS Solo & Ensemble, Concert & Sightreading Evaluation.
  - Question about UIL-contact me. This is very important so that you do not get bad advice from a friend or group chat about a UIL Rule.
  - ✓ Questions about TMEA-Region Band, Region Choir, Region Orchestra-contact your division chair
  - ✓ The UIL check should be addressed to: <u>UIL Music Region 27</u> and a new W-9 will be available prior to any fees being due.
  - ✓ If you are a new director at one of the smaller school districts, please send me an email with your contact information. I will get the director lists from the large school districts.

### 2. New UIL Rules: (Marching rules will be covered in HS Band Director Meeting)

- Section 1111(a)(3): SIGHT-READING EVALUATION. This amendment increases the committee member term from two years to three years.
- Section 1111(f)(9): SIGHT-READING EVALUATION. This amendment extends the two-part sight-reading option that exists for middle school and junior high choirs to high school choirs.
- Section 1112(a)(11): ADJUDICATION. This amendment removes the word maximum from the honorarium language.

### 3. UIL/TMEA Calendars Posted on the Website-Why are there 2 different calendars?

- Calendars may be updated after this meeting, so check the site periodically.

### 4. UIL Judges

### Judge (and Director) Ethics

- If a judge is evaluating any of your groups-they should not clinic any of your groups at your school.
- Adjudicators shall avoid fraternizing with competing directors, administrators, or school officials prior to or during the contest. (This goes both ways.)
- All TMAA members must prevent any real or perceived conflict of interest between adjudication of a UIL evaluation/contest and any organization participating in that event. (This also goes both ways.)

### 5. UIL Fees

The fee schedule will be posted on the website after the executive committee meeting on 8/24. I anticipate the fees to enter Marching, Concert & Sightreading will remain the same.

- ✓ If you are in a large district, please make sure you know what fees are paid by your district office and which fees you have to request at the school level.
- I anticipate that Solo & Ensemble fees will decrease. However, the final decision will be made on 8/24.
  - ✓ Late entries=\$5 per solo or ensemble member
  - ✓ Fees should be requested on the deadline when you finish your entries. They should be mailed to me ahead of time.

# 6. UIL Performance Order

- Division chairs will handle the draws in the division meetings.
- Draws will be posted on the website-left hand column next week

  - ✓ No changes once the schedule is published unless mutually agreed upon by two directors.
  - ✓ All effort will be made for groups to perform within their classification-smaller to larger. If at all possible, scheduling will start with Sub NV groups.

- If you choose to enter through CHARMS, you will still enter through CHARMS this school year. The UIL entry system is in Texas Music Forms or CHARMS. (Not Cut-Time).
- New teachers please register in Texas Music Forms soon.
- Returning directors-check and update your information.
- Spell out your school name including High School, Middle School, etc.
- You are required to use your school's TEA code when doing entries. Here is the link to find your code: <u>AskTED Search Screen (state.tx.us)</u>
- On Texas Music Forms, please use standard capitalization rules, correct spelling, <u>full words</u>, enter the correct division and enter the correct classification. The program is downloaded based on what you type.
- Enter only Region 27 events.
- Write down your login and password; use the online process to recover your information. Do not create another profile.
- Can't figure it out? Ask your colleague next door.

### 11. Preparing for UIL Concert Evaluation

- Understand the performance requirements. All COVID adjustments have expired.

- If you are playing part of a multi-movement work, please indicate the movements on your entry. You may type them next to the title.
- Judges are trained to use a rubric. You should also use it in preparing your ensembles. <u>https://www.uiltexas.org/music/concert-sight-reading/concert-sight-reading-adjudication-rubrics</u>

# 12. Public Domain Music, Electronic Downloads, and Permanently Out of Print Music:

- UIL requires that all music scores given to judges be copyright compliant. Any director utilizing music from public domain and/or electronic downloads must attach documentation indicating such.
- Photocopied scores that are POP must have a letter from the copyright holder giving permission to photocopy. Permission to photocopy POP scores may only be given by the copyright holder, not by a vendor.
- Permission to photocopy scores that have been ordered may granted by written permission from the vendor or copyright holder.
- Plan ahead and check your scores prior to contest day.
- Make sure your scores are numbered and that the movements are marked.
- Bring your scores to the contest office prior to performing.
- If you have a question about an edition that is different than the PML, please contact me early so that Mr. Musella may determine if it is an 'Unabridged' copy.

### 13. UIL Prescribed Music List

- The 2023-24 version goes live on September 1 on the UIL website. The only 'official' copy of the PML is on the UIL website.
- There are over 1,000 new pieces on the PML
- Many changes to the list were made this year, including changing the grades of some pieces. Make sure you check your titles and especially your titles for solo & ensemble.
- Many changes to the instrumental solo & ensemble list. Many new pieces-many pieces removed. It is time to update your music library.
- Check your solo & ensemble music carefully for required movements and instrumentation. Make sure to indicate which movements a student is playing on the form. This is the most frequent mistake at Solo & Ensemble. Call if you have a question, before you enter the event.
